



Equipment List for Each Patrol Box



- Set of towels to dry cooking equipment after washing
- Pot scrubbers
- SOS pads (should not need these very often)
- Extra knives, spoons, forks (used if scout forgets his own)
- Extra plates (used if scout forgets his mess kit)
- Extra cups (used if scout forgets his own)
- Two sets of BBQ tools (faster cooking, more participation)
- Can opener
- Cutting knives for food preparation
- Grill (1 or 2 small) - faster preparation. more participation)
- Trash bags
- Roll paper towels
- Matches (limited. handed out at each campout)
- Small tarp to cover patrol box when not under Troop structure
- Ladles. large perforated vegetable spoon
- Set of nested cooking pots
- Two skillets (either cast iron? Non-stick?)
- Mixing bowls
- Set of spices (salt. pepper. seasoned salt)
- Containers for
 - BBQ tools
 - Knives, spoons, forks Cutting knives - set of 4-6 Towels
 - Pot scrubbers
- Pump bottle of hand sanitizer
- Cutting board(s)

Things that do not go into Patrol boxes

- Ingredients for any food preparation - these need to be centrally managed
- Pump bottle of dish soap - all cleaning should be done on troop stove with fire buckets on patrol at a time
- Dutch ovens - troop cooking - may be done by one patrol for troop
- Large skillets (may no longer need)
- Tools and miscellaneous cooking gear
