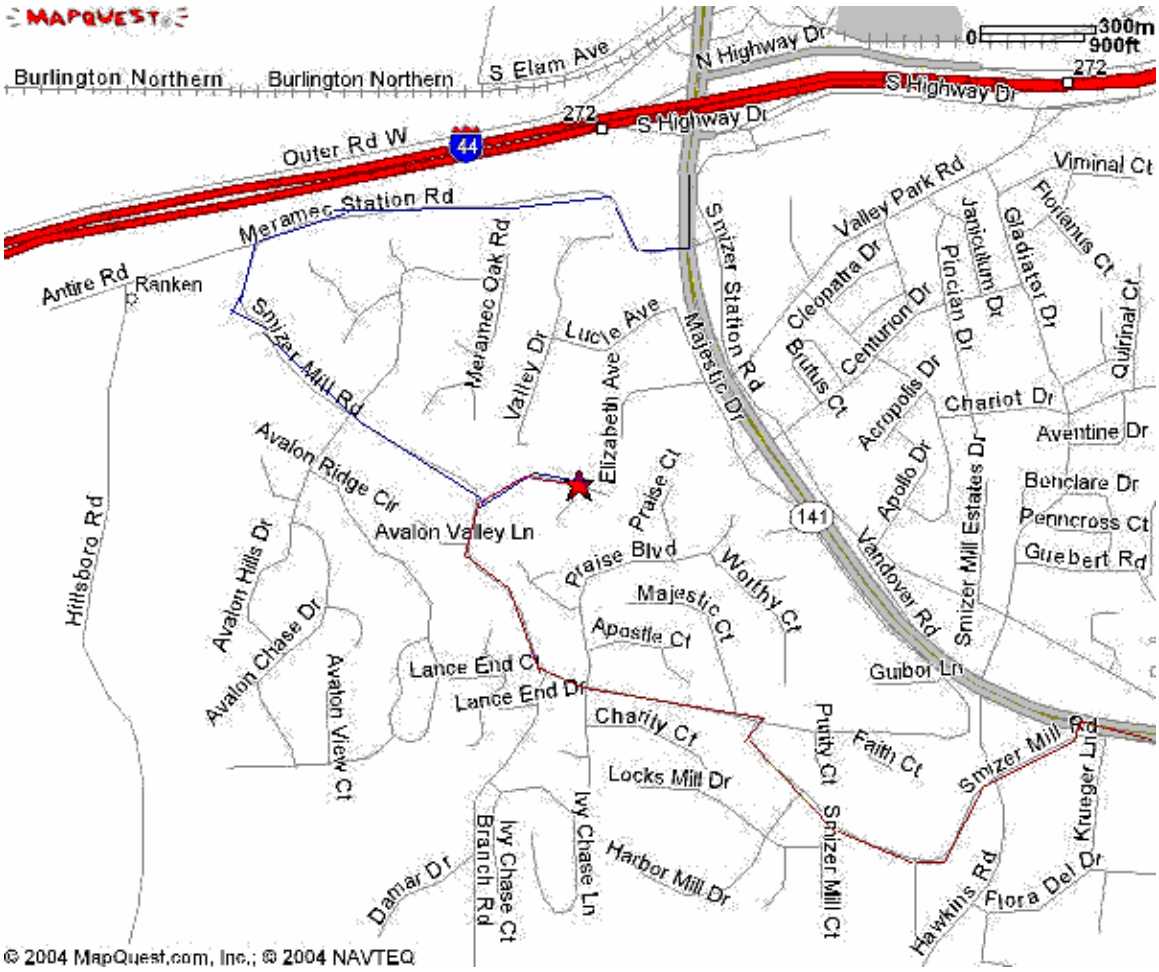
The project will be held in my garage.

Take 141 to Meramac Station Rd. (at the Shell Station) and drive until you get to a three-way intersection. Take a left onto Smizer Mill, drive past Avalon Hills and Meramec Meadows. The next left in my street, Salvation Ridge Ct. I live at #47 which is at the top of the hill.

Directions: (coming from Fenton)

Take 141 to Hawkins (turn south) and take a right onto Smizer Mill. Turn left at the stop sign and drive down the hill. Continue down Smizer Mill and across the bridge. The next right is my street, Salvation Ridge Ct. I live at #47 which is at the
