Level and disabled accessible.

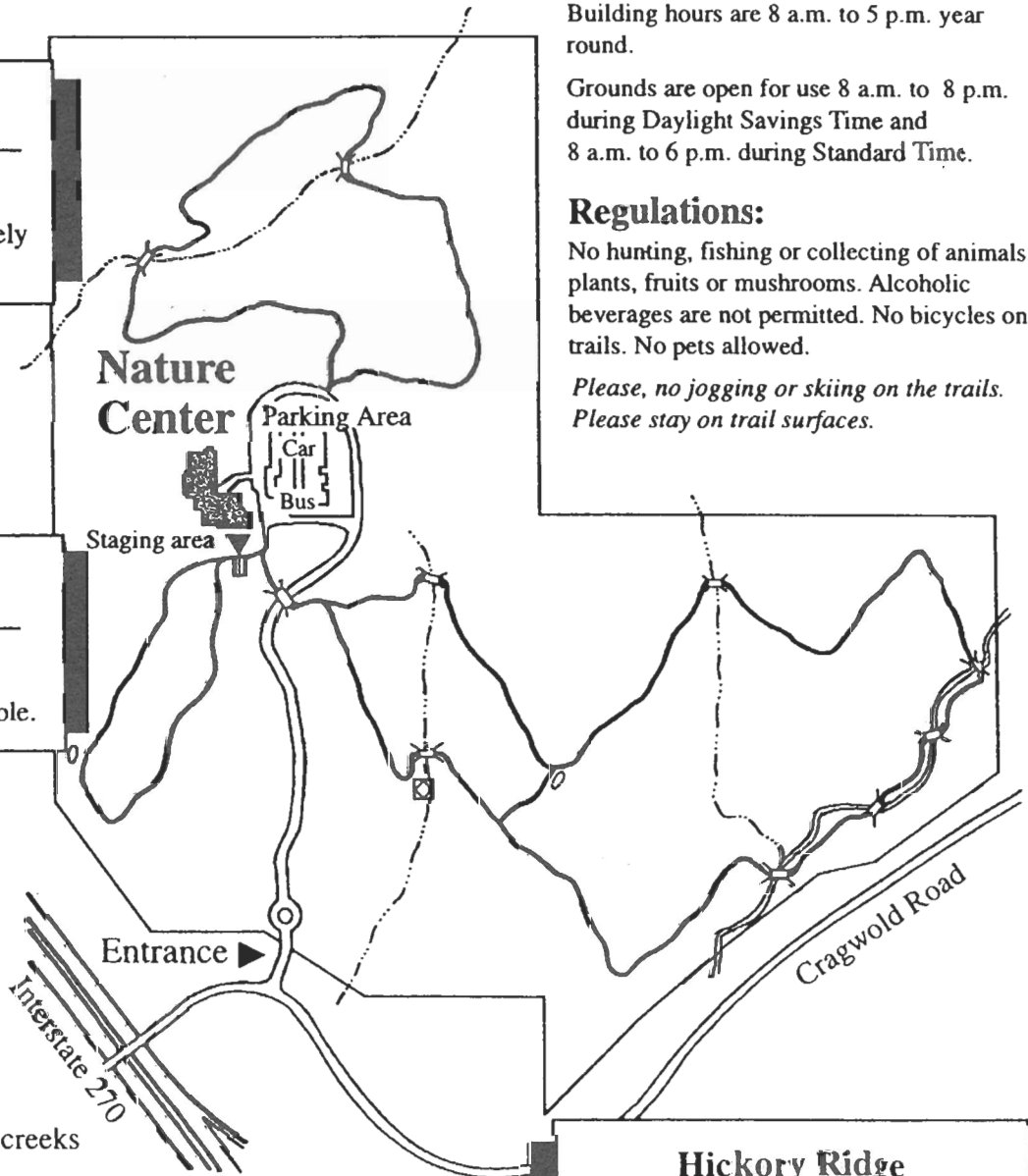
All Trails are Asphalt

Hours:

Building hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. year round.

Grounds are open for use 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. during Daylight Savings Time and 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. during Standard Time.

Regulations:

No hunting, fishing or collecting of animals, plants, fruits or mushrooms. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted. No bicycles on trails. No pets allowed.

Please stay on trail surfaces.*

Time – 1 1/4 hours

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Missouri Department of Conservation wants you to use the Conservation Nature Center, and its trails. In order for us to better serve you please observe the following rules and regulations.

The following are prohibited on the Powder Valley Conservation Nature Center:

- * Pets and Horses
- * Hunting, Fishing and Trapping
- * Camping and Fires
- * Picking, cutting or removing of edible wild greens, berries, mushrooms or other fruits
- * Capture and removal of any wildlife, including aquatic organisms
- * Picking, collection, destruction or defacing of any natural objects
- * Bicycles, non-motorized vehicles and other motorized vehicles on trails
(Permitted only in designated areas)
- * Alcoholic Beverages
- * Please no jogging or skiing on trails and **please stay on the trail surfaces.**
